The meeting took place in the Conference Room and started at 6 p.m. with a prayer by Dan Brown.

The following topics were discussed:

- **Ministry Fair:** Sabine Dieringer and Wendy Murray have put together our Ministry Booklet to showcase all that is going on at St. Eugene as well as hosting a Ministry Fair the weekend of November 7th & 8th. It was mentioned that the PPC should have a banner and representation for this weekend. Traci Davis volunteered to make the banner. Representation for each Mass as follows: Saturday 5:30 – Charlie Krug, Sunday 8:30 – Tommy Brooks, and 11:00 – Traci Davis. Our Mission Statement along with Commission Information will be passed out.
- **Turn Around/Overflow Lot:** Father Ed stated that we have paid over \$41,000 over the past 10 years to rent the gravel lot across from the church for parking. At present, we are paying \$421.00 a month. This lot holds around 30 cars which could be parked at Asheville Catholic School. The Finance Council gave the green light to stop renting this lot after December 1, 2009. If the owner is willing to sell at the right price, we would be willing to buy this property. During Holidays, we will optimize parking in the school parking lot as well as the lot where the rectory was once located.
- **Music Minister Candidates:** An ad has been placed in the Catholic News & Herald, the Raleigh Paper, the Charleston Catholic Miscellany as well as the Knoxville Paper. At present, we have received 1 resume.
